Yvonne has been actively involved in the educational scene for more than 20 years and has through the years taught students ranging from 5 to 17 years old.

Early Childhood Education was her curriculum major in the Institute of Education (now National Institute of Education). It was in those days that she grew to appreciate children's literature and inspired to develop creative and thinking skills in young children.

For a period of two years, she contributed monthly articles to the In TOUCH with the Family magazine. She wrote primarily on the value of quality picture books for young children and in particular, she shared generously to parents and teachers on the techniques of sharing character values through narratives.

From a pre-primary teacher, she moved on to become a primary school English Language teacher. It was in her second school, Northland Primary School that she rose to become the first Head of Department for English. Through the years, she helped to lead her team of dedicated teachers to raise the school's quality passes [A and A\*] for PSLE English from below national average to a healthy 8% above national average. To date, the school continues to enjoy high quality grades that consistently surpass the national average.

Being an avid reader herself, she was active in promoting

reading and the love for books in children. The reading programme "I Would Rather Read" was introduced to the school and had significantly increased the library loan rate amongst the Primary 1, 2 and 3 students from 25% to 80%. This was a whole-year project that eventually won the school's first Gold Award in the National Quality Circles Convention.

Her educational career took a different turn when she left the MOE to become the residential Programme Director of Learning Point, a private enrichment centre. Her achievements include spearheading a couple of whole-year language enrichment courses for primary school gifted students as well as Integrated Programme (IP) for secondary school students.

Her forte in Learning Point is not so much as to teach creative writing but more in creating the environment and facilitating group activities to allow students to blossom. Under her influence, more than 5 of her students were nominated to participate in the Creative Arts Programme (CAP) jointly organized by the MOE's Gifted Education Branch and NUS' University Scholars Programme.

To keep herself relevant and in touch with the current educational scene, Yvonne regularly conducts classroom management and language-related and creativity courses for her associate trainers under the Mastereign Enrichment Group.

Her first book, *Living Lasting Legacy: A Journey To Begin*, published by Rank Books in 2004, is written with the desire to get young people thinking about living a life that counts. Her second book will be a light-hearted but practical book for facilitators and trainers who want to excel in the teaching and training industry.

She has a degree in Bachelor of Arts in English Language and Literature. But her learning has never stopped as she regularly feeds herself with good literature and daily associates herself with fine company.

### YCS 003 Interview Skills *(Secondary & Junior College)*

Learn how to prepare and handle difficult questions posed by the interviewers. Plenty of small group interactions and role-plays.

### YCS 001 Show & Speak *(Lower Primary)*

Enjoy the varied opportunities for verbal expression in a stress-free and fun-filled environment. The many interactive activities that make use of authentic objects, creative movements and striking images will inspire students to share their ideas and improve confidence in speaking before a small audience.

Learn and develop comprehension skills such as recognising sequence of details, picking main ideas, drawing inferences and identifying context clues through a variety of fun and interactive activities and worksheets. Challenging worksheets will be given to paraphrase, predict, analyse and understand the given texts better.

### YCE 003 Enhanced Comprehension & Summary *(Secondary)*

Students get to review techniques of answering comprehension and summary questions in the 'O' Level English Paper 2. Through the application of comprehension and summary skills, students will grow to be more mindful of the common types of exam questions and gain greater confidence in the tackling of a full-length comprehension and summary paper.

## You Can Write!

A series of writing modules that adds dazzle and depth to students' writing



### YCW 001 Creative Writing (Primary & Secondary)

Learn to apply essential elements of the story such as structure, themes, plot, characterization, dialogue and aspects of the writer's craft to produce interesting narratives. There'll be opportunities to read interesting short stories and pick up tips on effective writing techniques. Lot of fun hands-on activities to apply the techniques learned. Students will pick up a range of writing strategies, hone their observation skills and discover their personal voice. They'll enjoy the range of exercises and activities designed to ignite their creative writing spark in fiction, poetry and life writing.

### YCW 002 Periodical of Prose (Secondary)

A survey of literature to enhance the abilities and creative capabilities of high ability secondary students. Throughout this course, the primary objective is to guide students to understand the elements that are incorporated in all short story writing. Hence the diverse range of literature to inspire students to grow from one level to another. To improve students' writing in a fun, interactive environment there will be lots of open, respectful discussion. Students get to share their pieces while giving feedback and constructive responses by peers and teacher.

### YCW 003 Journalism (Primary & Secondary)

Aimed at introducing students who are good writers to the basics of journalism. Skills for newspaper report writing - like sniffing out a potential story, collecting information, interviewing and writing.

### YCW 004 Narratives and Recounts (Secondary)

Students get to review the techniques of writing narratives which include characterization, dialogues, creating mood and atmosphere, writing with a point of narrative conflict in mind and writing from first and third persons. Students will also review differences of factual and personal recount, recounts and narratives and finally differentiate between a feature article and a news report.

### YCW 005 Expository & Argumentative Writing (Secondary)

Using the "English-across-the Curriculum" approach, students learn the rudiments of the expository and argumentative essay. In the expository section, students will be closely guided and then taught to apply the skills acquired to produce a coherent piece of expository essay. In the argumentative section, they will be taught how to put together a convincing argument, how to avoid fallacies and sweeping statements to successfully construct a convincing case.

### YCEL 001 Appreciating Local Short Stories (Pr 4 - Sec 2) 2011-12 NAC-AEP

Four short stories by Catherine Lim, Tan Mei Ching, Ovidia Yu and Ho Minfong will be used. Their stories depict the adventures and lives of Singaporeans and other nationals, craftily woven with literary techniques that are worthy of a closer look not only as texts for secondary school students but also for those who enjoy literature as a leisurely read. Full-filled interactive activities are included to draw on the students' experiences and to help them engage fully with the characters.



### YCEL 002 Enjoy & Write Poetry (Upper Primary)

Students will be introduced to poetry as something they can easily pick up to read, enjoy and write. Freedom, spontaneity and experimentation will be encouraged throughout even though they will also be expected to use structural poetic forms and basic conventions of poetry that seemingly restrict and bound them. As they are led through the whole writing process, they will be challenged to look for the best angle to approach their subject matter and also relish the joy of successfully finding the right word at the right time.

### YCEL 003 Literature Appreciation (Upper Primary)

Selected texts will be examined at the narrative and symbolic level. Through appropriate activities, students learn to respond critically and creatively through oral responses, written responses, artistic responses such as illustrating and creating a scrapbook and actions such as role-play.

## ACY 001 Quantum Memory

## AF 001 Developing Creative Ideas Through Magic (Upper Primary and beyond)

All of us are born creative. Yet many still think that they are not creative enough. The truth is that they have not been taught that their innate creativity can be nurtured and enhanced through the use of deliberate tools, techniques and strategies. This course will bring about a greater appreciation of the creative mind and the application of creative thinking in planning and communication.



## AF 002 Poetry & Music (Upper Primary and beyond)

This is a perfect course to turn students on to poetry. Popular music and lyrics will be used to analyse poetic devices such as rhyme and rhythm, imagery, onomatopoeia, personification, alliteration, metaphors and similes. Underlying social messages for selected songs will be analysed and followed by sharing sessions, journal writing and finally poetry writing.

## AF 003 E'mazing English Race (All levels)

Here's a chance for students to outrun, outsmart and outlast one another through structured, fun-filled language activities, physical games and team building exercises that bring fun, laughter and challenge to the learning process. The experience aims to stretch students' bodies and minds and reinforces the values of Efficiency, Effectiveness and Excellence.



## AF 004 Photo-journalism (Upper Primary and beyond)

The art of combining powerful images and choice words to convey a message requires an eye for design, perspective and a sense of creative adventure. This course expose students to this art and at the end of it they will find themselves more skilful in digital photography and expository writing. By integrating Information of Communication Technology (ICT) into the English language, students get to learn the technical aspect of video production such as basic camera techniques (shot sizes, composition and framing). By applying journalistic writing skills - interviewing and editing - they will produce a short video broadcast or mini documentary that highlights a specific school event or a social issue.

Recording and preserving memories of special milestones, exciting school events and even everyday happenings can be exciting and creative. Using a basic template and appropriate paper scraps, students are taught how to create a sizeable album with relevant journal entries to chronicle important events and preserve precious emotions.
