We offer a comprehensive leadership programme consisting of a suite of leadership mastery modules. It is aimed at equipping participants with leadership mastery skills through a progressive curriculum

Everyone is a Leader



LP 004 Growing a Team

As the team matures and becomes more established over time, the leader must develop the necessary skills to continue to grow and facilitate the team in depth and breadth. Participants will be taught how to create strong and cohesive teams that will be sanctioned to make good and constructive decisions for the larger good.

LP 001 Basic Concepts of Leadership

Anyone can become an effective leader if they have the desire to make a positive difference. Participants will be given an overview of the basic concepts of leadership theories and methodologies such as the Factors of Leadership, Leadership Models, the Be-Know-Do-Learn Leadership Framework, and the Kouzes-Posner's Leadership Challenge.

LP 002 Leading with a Vision

An effective leader needs to proactively search for constructive direction and provide a clear and achievable vision for the team. Participants will learn the premises and rationale of visioning, how and what to envision and how this should align itself for the overall benefit of the team that he is leading.

LP 003 Inspiring a Shared Vision

A leader's vision must not be a self-centred orientation. Instead, his vision must be shared and resonate among his team members so that the entire team is inspired and there is a genuine effort by everyone to bring out the best in the team's goals. Participants will learn how to facilitate shared visions that will create synergy for the team in the long term.

LP 005 Encouraging a Team

In this module, participants will learn how to read the signals of team members being "burnt out", give regular encouragement that is genuine and specific and avoid 'textbook' means of showing support. Consequently, it is inevitable that the leader must develop a genuine interest in the lives of his team in order to effectively encourage the team well.

LP 006 **Knowing the Team**

A leader must not just lead the team and develop himself, he must also seek to understand the behaviour and characteristics of his followers in order to bring out the best in each and everyone of them. Students will be equipped with basic emotional and interpersonal skills in order to bring about this synergy.

LP 008 **Leadership Communication Skills**

Enhancing communication between the leader and his team is crucial in creating smoother workflows and in deepening interpersonal understanding. This can be established through clearing the 'barriers' of communication, empathic listening and learning how to manage conflicts effectively. Furthermore, when real and deep communication happens, mutual trust is developed and this inevitably brings about a greater unity in the team.

LP 010 **Change Management**

Leadership involves looking and re-looking at present systems and processes to see how these can be changed for the betterment of the team. The basis and rationale of change making will be taught and different scenarios will be given to participants on how they can develop creative and constructive ideas to challenge and overcome current processes.

LP 007 **Enabling and Multiplying the Team**

Leaders must continue to nurture and develop teams that are self-managing rather than merely following instructions. Participants will learn the basis of empowerment, what/how to empower and how to handle difficult situations constructively.

LP 009 **Servant Leadership**

Servant Leadership requires leaders to be more than just managers, executing pre-planned tasks and administering based on 'standard procedures', but also to undertake the extra responsibility required to serve the team. Participants will understand the difficult yet deeply fundamental qualities of a servant-like leader, one who is able to build into the lives of others and an encouragement and inspiration for others.

LP 011 **Project Management**

In learning how to manage projects, participants learn time-management, resource-management, people-management and risk assessment skills. This course will allow participants to practice planning and taking on different roles in managing a project through experiential learning and activities to instil in them the important values needed for effective project management.

Study Skills

We aim to develop effective study skills in participants through a series of learning strategies



BASIC MODULES

GE 001 **I Am Motivated!**

Students will understand the different traits of motivation and how they can sustain it in their pursuit of not just academic excellence, but for a sense of purpose and fulfilment in life. The course will include interesting and interactive student-based activities, testimonials and videos of extraordinary people, and inspiring stories to draw out the various traits of self-motivation.

GE 003 **Effective Time Management**

Time management is the essential skill that helps keep work under control and stress to a minimum. Time itself is non-renewable, hence understanding your relationship with time and knowing how to manage it is most important in reaching your goals and ambitions. This course is an excellent introduction to students who have never planned anything in their life, as well as for those who wish to excel at time management.

GE 005 **Cornell Notes Taking Method**

In this practical programme, students will learn a systematic way for condensing and organizing notes. After writing the notes in the main space, the left-hand space is used to label each idea and detail with a key word or question or any appropriate short phrase (known as 'cue' in the Cornell method).

I am a Genius

GE 002 **SMART Goals**

Students will partake in activities and watch videos that will simulate different situations where time management and organization is needed. Through experiential learning, students will learn how to set S.M.A.R.T. goals and keep the big picture in mind.

GE 004 **Memory Techniques**

Students will understand the various memory techniques needed for daily studies and examination preparation as well as applying various tools to help them better recall and synthesize learnt material.

GE 006 **Independent Study & Reflection / Balance Work & Play**

Students will learn how to be more self-directed in their study habits and recognize that life is more than just all play or all work but a balance of the two. They will have opportunities to do lots of personal and group reflection so that they can learn more about their need to be responsible for self-learning and reflection instead of being overly dependent on the external environment.

ADVANCED MODULES

GE 007 Problem-Solving Skills

This course aims to develop self-confidence when faced with problems, whether in or out of school. Students will learn the steps for more effective and rational decision making. They will be involved in group discussions and presentations, and have practical hands-on experience to take a problem and solve it systematically during the course. Students will also learn tools such as 5W&1H, SWOT analysis, Fishbone and PEST to enable them to analyze problems in class, with their families and their friends.

GE 009 Creative and Innovative Thinking

Creativity thinking skills are about attitude and the confidence to be open to new and unconventional ideas. In this fun-filled experiential course, participants will be involved in creative activities to generate new ideas to solve old problems. They will also learn about inspirational real-life examples of how creativity and innovative thinking have enabled people and companies to recreate history.

GE 008 Critical and Analytical Thinking Skills

Critical and analytical thinking is an important skill as students' progress in their course of study and life. In this experiential course, participants will engage in group observations, discussions and presentations towards lines of reasoning to arrive at logical conclusions of opinions. In this course, participants will understand the importance of reasoning and questioning, and organization of thought process. They will become more aware of the consequences of actions and through personal reflections, thereby able to reach a higher level of awareness in their speeches and actions.

GE 010 Effective Reading & Research Strategies

Students will learn various primary and secondary research strategies in order to gather data and evidences to build up their argument/case. They will also learn to discriminate between valid, reliable data vs anecdotal evidences so that they become more discerning when making value judgments.

Personal Effectiveness



I Am Important

PE 001 Be A CHAMP! - Character Building

Through a series of modules, participants would identify and develop the foundations of their character, following guiding principles of integrity, responsibility, self-motivation, empathy, courage, perseverance, self-control, gratitude. The lessons consist of student-based activities that will enhance their understanding and allow them to embrace the keys to being highly effective people.

PE 003 Handyman

There has been talk about the generation of youths who may be overly-dependant on domestic helpers and technology to do basic work for them. This course aims to equip students by giving participants practical technical skills that are essential in living independently, such as basic cooking skills, plumbing, ironing, sewing, and maintaining electrical appliances.

PE 002 Jump Start! (Transition between Primary, Secondary & Tertiary levels)

As students transit between levels, many face new challenges, higher expectations and stumbling blocks that could potentially hinder their learning and assimilation into the new school environment. This course helps students to successfully adjust so that students can enjoy and excel in their studies and other activities during their school years.

PE 004 Know Yourself - Self Evaluation and Profiling (DISC)

This module is based on the DISC profiling and modelling tool. Students will learn the following:

- Identify individuals' strengths and weaknesses through DISC Profiling
- Grow from "comfort zones" into "growth (groan) zones".
- Knowing yourself encourages openness and adaptability. This helps to reduce conflicts and stress as well as enhance inter-personal communications.

Everyone is gifted and unique. Identifying your individual DISC profile will enable you to focus on your strengths in career planning.

PE 005 **Maximizing Your Intelligence (VAK & Multiple Intelligences)**

Participants will understand the different intelligences within themselves. They will be trained to acquire the right mindsets, attitudes and methods for acquiring knowledge. The ability to grow their intelligences will motivate them to raise their self-esteem and confidence. The objective is to place in the hands of the participants some easy-to-use keys to unlock the fears they have and to unleash their potential.

PE 007 **Stress Management**

Stress is a common symptom in a fast-paced society such as ours. While stress can be an impelling factor in many circumstances, it can result in destructive behaviour. This course aims to teach participants how to manage stress through understanding their emotions, learning some key lessons in life, managing their time, setting priorities and using various stress control techniques in various situations.

PE 006 **Personal Learning Style (VAK)**

This module allows the participants to find out their personal preferred learning method - whether their strength is in being a Visual Learner, Auditory Learner or a Kinesthetic Learner. Participants get to understand their personal Learning Strengths, know how to use their own Learning Strategies to maximize their ability to absorb knowledge, and how to play to their strengths during Exams. They will reflect individually and in groups on suggested learning methods to strengthen their personal learning style.

PE 008 **Anger Management**

Anger as an emotion is a normal, instinctive response to a threatening and dangerous situation. Sometimes, it causes us to act irrationally when unleashed without direction or thought. The healthy way to deal with anger is not to ignore it, or to let it dominate us irrationally, but to acknowledge the anger and then, intentionally, manage the anger from a more objective perspective. Through hands-on activities, this course aims to educate participants on what anger is, ways to manage your anger and practical tools on how you can successfully overcome your anger.

Interpersonal Effectiveness



IE 001 **Cyber-Wellness**

Cyberwellness encompasses concerns around safety and security online and deals with people's psychological and emotional well being as they log on to the internet. In keeping up with today's social changes, participants need to be educated on the latest cyber-skills to protect themselves from predatory influences, cyber-bullying, chatroom dangers, dating strangers met in cyberspace, online pornography / gaming / gambling and 'phishing'.

IE 003 **Anti-Bullying**

Participants will learn the definition of a "bully" and 'strong arm tactics' and why bullies exist. They will learn how to successfully cope and overcome the tactics of bullies, and resources for seeking help from bullies. They will learn the background of school bullying in Singapore and around the world. They will be briefed on understanding who bullies are and characteristics of bullies, the difference between school bullies and 'outside of school' bullies, and hear real-life stories of bullies and the consequences of their behaviour.

IE 002 **Service With A Heart - Service Learning / Community Involvement Program (CIP)**

Service learning is the integration of meaningful community service with guidance and reflection in order to teach civic responsibility and encourage lifelong social engagement. Beyond being actively engaged in the project, participants will have the opportunity to select, design, implement, and evaluate their service activity, encouraging relevancy, sustaining interest and developing the self-confidence to voice their concerns.

IE 004 **Effective Parenting**

How would you like to put a smile on your child's face? How do I face the uphill task of parenting my child as he/she moves on to be a young adult? How do I strike the balance between discipline and respect while nurturing my child? How can I be the "positive" parent I always wanted to be? In this module, parents go through topics including "Knowing Your Children", "Listening To Their Felt Needs", "How To Talk To Your Children Effectively", "Discipline That Works: Setting The Rules And Boundaries", "Organising The Household" and "Money Management For Kids".

Communication Skills



CS 001 Public Speaking

Participants will gain a thorough understanding of what public speaking entails and how we can use it as a powerful tool. They will develop and improve their language usage and skills in writing effective speeches. Participants will be taught how to bring their speech alive through expressive vocabulary, appropriate variation in intonation and enhanced pronunciation. They will learn the importance of verbal and non verbal communication including body language and eye contact, use of visual aids and cues, as well as audience-management skills to overcoming their fears and to ensure the speech is delivered effectively.

CAREER / JOB INTERVIEWS



CS 003 Resume Writing

A good resume can bolster your chances of standing out and being selected for an interview. You have more information to put on your resume than you might think. You will learn the importance of preparation, how to research information about the organisation, and how to complete a Sample Job Application Form. You will learn how to obtain References / Testimonials and who you should go to for that very important Reference.

CS 005 Social Customs

Every society has patterns of behaviour that determines acceptable and unacceptable actions in particular situations. Participants learn the meaning and importance of social customs in interpersonal relations; understanding Chinese, Malay, Indian and Eurasian cultures to gain a greater appreciation for the variety of cultural experiences.

CS 002 Presentation Skills

A Presentation is not restricted to verbal communication between audience and presenter. This course introduces the fundamental points of making an effective presentation through maximizing the use of various multimedia and visual aids and props. Participants will acquire the knowledge of visual aid selection, skills to engage their audience and learn how to effectively handle questions.

CS 004 Interview Skills

Participants will be taught how to leave a lasting impression on the interviewer that goes beyond paper qualifications. They will be equipped with proper interview etiquette and skills to market themselves. Besides that, participants will learn how to manage their feelings of fear or nervousness, hence developing their self-confidence during interviews, and allowing them to perform at their best during the interviews. The aim of this session is for the participants to understand the purpose and demands of an interview. It will be conducted in an activity-based style, which would enable participants to have a hands-on approach to responding in an interview and to try out being in the shoes of the interviewer.

CS 006 Stage Etiquette

This course will equip participants with the knowledge and skills of hosting a formal function plus how to give it an extra touch of glamour. You will learn the basic skills of stage presence, deportment, presentation skills, ushering and how to walk onto the stage to accept prize presentations. You will also learn how to emcee an event, manage the different types of microphones, proper prior logistical preparations, mental preparations and stage posture.

AFS 001 Leadership Through Commanderz!

Through the various game sets of Speed Tag, leadership skills and knowledge will be imparted to the students in a fun, hands-on and enjoyable way. Our Leadership Commanderz activities are:

Leadership!

Students rotate responsibility to lead the Team and learn how to work together. They will learn to look at objectives and expected to contribute to the success of the Team.

Outnumbered

One team has reduced number of players. They have to quickly come up with a strategy immediately to play against the odds. Through this game, they will learn to overcome obstacles and challenges that they face in their future.

Blindfold

All team members are blindfolded except the leader. They will have to listen to the instructions of the leader to move and to shoot. They will learn to work together and to listen to instructions. The leader has to learn to communicate effectively under time and stress constraints.

Speak Out

No team member is allowed to remain silent for more than 7 seconds - otherwise they are out. They cannot use meaningless words or repetition but must communicate aloud within the team. Students will learn the importance of constant communication to build understanding, minimise conflicts and to work towards a common goal as a Team.



AFS 002 Presentation through Drama

Participants will participate in a Drama, with the focus on essential activities for good presentation skills. Intonation, voice projection and body language will be imparted to the students in fun and enjoyable ways. Drama is infused with the technical training required for a good presentation!



AFS 003 Understanding Myself through Method Acting

Method acting is a way for actors to recreate the thoughts and emotions of their characters and to develop realistic performances. By infusing these techniques and activities in our character education programme, students will discover their real selves, develop their characters and learn how to interact and communicate with other actors.

Social Graces & Personal Grooming

Making a good first impression is important for building relationships with other people. We aim to groom the participants in the areas of dressing, mannerism, etiquette, appearance and interpersonal skills, thus covering every aspect to create that unforgettable first and lasting impression. Courseware is developed in collaboration with the International Beauty & Image Consultants Association (IBICA)



SG 003 Healthy Hair

Hair is an important part of a person's visual presentation. The state and style of a person's hair is crucial to one's image, often determining one's confidence. In this module, participants learn to care for their scalp and hair through proper washing, conditioning and treatment. They also learn basic hair styling.

SG 005 Body Language & Deportment

A popular workshop where participants learn about one's natural alignment and correct standing/sitting/walking posture. Through this, they can appear to have more charisma. Participants will also be exposed to the mastery of body language and gesturing techniques.

PACKAGES

SG 007 First Impressions

Making a good first impression is important for building relationships. This is a holistic breakthrough programme to groom participants in all areas leading towards social graces and personal grooming. The skills cover dressing, mannerism, etiquette, appearance and interpersonal skills and other aspects to create that unforgettable first impression. The skills will help build your personal relationships, broadening your social skills and for job or scholarship interviews.

SG 009 Best Executive

This workshop prepares participants with skills to portray themselves as professionals confidently when they enter the workforce. They will learn how to leave a favourable impression on the interviewer, giving them an edge in addition to paper qualifications. The workshop includes modules on appropriate dress codes, behavioural conduct, conversational skills interviews and resume writing.

FUSION PROGRAMMES

SG 011 Body Beautiful

This programme motivates and inspires the participants to get into shape. Through practical activities to tackle malnutrition and overweight issues, participants learn about their body shapes and the specific exercises they require. Fitness trainers will lead the participants through exciting fitness regimes, nutrition planning and controlled food intakes to sculpt their desired figures.

BASIC MODULES

SG 001 Vitality

This module provides participants learning points about hygiene practices, bodily wellness and leading a healthy life. Through practical tips, participants learn to achieve vitality, preventing health implications and illnesses.

SG 002 New Face

More than skin deep, this module provides participants the fundamentals of facial skin care. They learn to how to obtain and maintain a healthy complexion. They also learn to prevent blemishes, scarring and signs of aging. This module also includes basic principles of make-up.

SG 004 Wardrobe Style

This module provides participants practical knowledge on dressing. Here, they understand how to dress appropriately for an occasion. They learn about different styles of dressing through proper accessories and colour-matching to one's skin one. Create your own personal branding and unleash the X factor in you today!

SG 006 Dining Etiquette PLUS

Table manners is extremely important as it is often an indication of one's upbringing. Through various vocal exercises, proper body language, gesturing, self-introductions, handshakes, dress sense and learning to be sensitive to their guests, participants are equipped with the knowledge and skills of hosting a formal function.
