Yvonne has been actively involved in the educational scene for more than 20 years and has through the years taught students ranging from 5 to 17 years old.

Early Childhood Education was her curriculum major in the Institute of Education (now National Institute of Education). It was in those days that she grew to appreciate children's literature and inspired to develop creative and thinking skills in young children.

For a period of two years, she contributed monthly articles to the In TOUCH with the Family magazine. She wrote primarily on the value of quality picture books for young children and in particular, she shared generously to parents and teachers on the techniques of sharing character values through narratives.

From a pre-primary teacher, she moved on to become a primary school English Language teacher. It was in her second school, Northland Primary School that she rose to become the first Head of Department for English. Through the years, she helped to lead her team of dedicated teachers to raise the school's quality passes [A and A*] for PSLE English from below national average to a healthy 8% above national average. To date, the school continues to enjoy high quality grades that consistently surpass the national average.

Being an avid reader herself, she was active in promoting reading and the love for books in children. The reading programme "I Would Rather Read" was introduced to the school and had significantly increased the library loan rate amongst the Primary 1, 2 and 3 students from 25% to 80%. This was a whole-year project that eventually won the school's first Gold Award in the National Quality Circles Convention.

Her educational career took a different turn when she left the MOE to become the residential Programme Director of Learning Point, a private enrichment centre. Her achievements include spearheading a couple of whole-year language enrichment courses for primary school gifted students as well as Integrated Programme (IP) for secondary school students.

Her forte in Learning Point is not so much as to teach creative writing but more in creating the environment and

facilitating group activities to allow students to blossom. Under her influence, more than 5 of her students were nominated to participate in the Creative Arts Programme (CAP) jointly organized by the MOE's Gifted Education Branch and NUS' University Scholars Programme.

To keep herself relevant and in touch with the current educational scene, Yvonne regularly conducts classroom management and language-related and creativity courses for her associate trainers under the Mastereign Enrichment Group.

Her first book, *Living Lasting Legacy: A Journey To Begin*, published by Rank Books in 2004, is written with the desire to get young people thinking about living a life that counts. Her second book will be a light-hearted but practical book for facilitators and trainers who want to excel in the teaching and training industry.

She has a degree in Bachelor of Arts in English Language and Literature. But her learning has never stopped as she regularly feeds herself with good literature and daily associates herself with fine company.

PAL 005 Music Time Machine

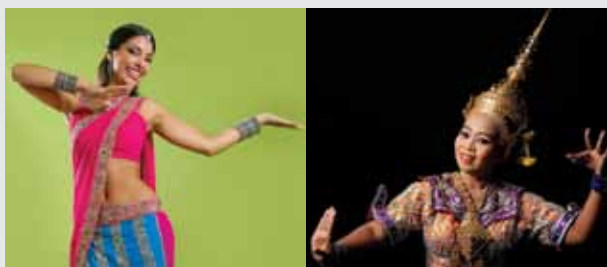

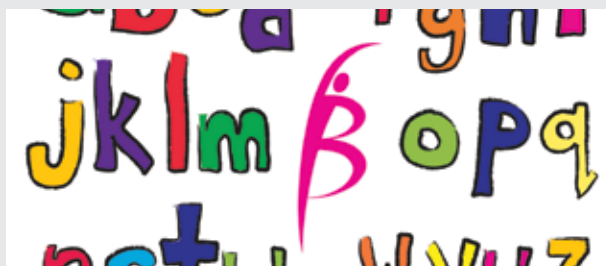
PAL 008 Creative Movement and Dance

PAL 017 AniKinetics

"AniKinetics" or "AK" Fun Fitness Workshop is an abbreviation of "Animal Kinetics". This sports series is themed around animal movements and actions. It presents different challenges to students based on the respective prowess of animals such as the Cheetah (Speed), Frog (Jump), Bat (Agility) and Mammoth (Strength) to develop their fundamental sporting skills and at the same time develop an appreciation of their body's ability to perform various movements. Students will be taken on a series of exciting scenarios which they have to accomplish and overcome through imitating the jungle animals. With this module, students will not only develop their physical strength and endurance but also hone their imagination and creativity in the process.



PAL 019 World Cup Dreams

The Fifa World Cup is probably one of the greatest sporting events in the world today, attracting hundreds of millions of spectators and viewers all over the world. In this programme, students will experience the journey of a World Cup soccer star.
