MPE 001 Banker

Bankers are important players in financial markets and offer financial services such as investment funds. The role of a banker is to act as a representative for customers and to borrow and lend money. In addition, they are also equipped to advise and offer services pertaining to insurance.



MPE 002 Journalist

Journalism is the dissemination of information about current events, trends, issues, and people while striving for a non-bias viewpoint. A journalist puts the information in their own words, making it creative in their own way so it will catch the reader's or viewer's attention.



MPE 003 Music Director/ Producers

The title of music director is used by many symphony orchestras to introduce the primary conductor and artistic leader of the orchestra. The music director does not only conduct concerts but also decide what music the orchestra will perform or record and has much authority over musicians.



MPE 004 Creative Director

A Creative Director is usually associated with the advertising, media or entertainment industries, but may also be found in other creative organizations such as web development and software development firms as well. Their main role is to interpret a client's communications strategy and then develop the creative approaches.

EM 001 Film Commercial

Students will learn how to create visual stories, bringing the message across in 45 seconds or less. This programme allows students to create TV commercials with a strong emphasis on selling a product to the targeted audience. They will also be guided through brainstorming sessions to generate various ideas and making the critical decision of selecting only the best.



EM 002 Branding Designer

This module exposes students to art concepts and ideas to create and design corporate aesthetics. Participants will learn how to create digital logos, and with those skills, create corporate products like letterheads, name cards and envelopes. Students will be required to present the whole package in a presentation design that explains their digital design direction. The end product will be a unique output that pertains to students' visual own product in a stylized digital rendering.



EM 004 Graphic Designer

Students will be introduced to art concepts and ideas, while at the same time fusing visual elements into a digital end product. This course aims to integrate visual elements like sketching, form and illustration while fusing it with digital elements like enhancing and airbrushing. It also aims to expose students to the many varieties of digital output available not only to the standard poster end product but also to challenge students to cross the boundaries into digital design for TV output, digital prints for banners, logos and t-shirt designs, using industry-standard software.



EM 006 Digital Photographer

This course allows students to understand the use of DSLRs, which are often preferred by professional still photographers because they allow an accurate preview of framing close to the moment of exposure, choice of variety of interchangeable lenses and also a function that allows accurate preview of depth of field. Students will learn how professional photographers work from capturing moments of an event to framing shots for publications.



EM 008 Mobile Game Developer

This course will guide students to use the simplest ways to create games. Students need not have the knowledge of programming codes and with the help of game editors; they can start building their own entertainment game in no time. In addition, students will be exposed to different genres of games and understand game mechanics and game play of each game genre. Students will also get to produce series of side-scrolling games, platform 2D games and shooting games.



EM 003 Stop Motion Animator

The main objective of this course is to give students the experience of creating their personal models from materials such as clay or plasticine and also stop motion video production incorporated into classroom learning styles. Students will experience creating stop motion video with models they have created, conceptualizing the storyline and having the models act out the scenes instead of using live characters. This course bundles aesthetic learning processes with conceptualization of the storyline, creating of the material model, animating the characters and capturing the motion on video. Coupled with video editing software as a tool, students will move onto a journey of editing their videos, adding sound sounds and music as accompaniment, thus producing an aesthetic model animated video.

EM 005 Product Design & Innovation

Design and Innovation, part of our broad-based education, engages students to build awareness and appreciation of design processes from aesthetics and functionality of design to application of knowledge and skills. This course focuses on the basic aspect of Design and Technology (D&T), Design Awareness, Purpose of Design Application, Drawing and Rendering and Presentation. This course is designed to explore and hone the students' creativity. It exposes students to various concepts of the art design by guiding them to work with the latest versions of industry-standard digital art applications.



EM 007 2D/3D Animation

The objective of this course is to introduce students to computer animation in a creative and dynamic environment. Apart from equipping students with the knowledge in the latest animation technology, this highly interactive course also aims at drawing out student's imagination and creativity to the fullest potential and exposing them to industrial standards and applications.

Performance Arts

EM 013 Performing Musician

This course offers a step-by-step approach to playing musical instruments, namely keyboards, guitars or percussion instruments. Through this module, students will develop the interest and ability to play music freely. Not only does this course feature an approach that is based on playing what is heard, students will get to play together as an ensemble. This means that they will be able to experience the "feel" and energy that come from playing with others. On top of that, students will be trained the proper techniques to play different platforms of instruments. The possibility is endless.

EM 015 Modelling

Students will realise after completing this course that there are many different types of modelling jobs apart from those commonly associated with a catwalk model. This informative course aims to give some preparatory tips to those who want to be a model and also explore the different avenues and prospect of this career choice.



EM 017 DJ Spin Master

The objective of this course is to introduce students to the art of being a DJ. Students get to experience the role of a DJ and will be exposed to the use of the DJ equipment and basic DJ presentation skills. Emphasis will be placed on building up and improving the oral presentation skills of students as it is an essential skill of successful DJs. The course also enhances students' creativity in creating music remixes and challenges them to build their own signature grooves through computer technology and DJ consoles.

Em 019 Musical Theatre Artist

This course will focus on the 'three threats' in performing. They are acting, singing and dance. Students will be introduced to musical theatre and develop basic skills in acting, singing and dance while understanding more about musical theatre as a career. A learning journey will be included as part of their knowledge gained about theatre. Students will work on a scene and work towards dramatising it before finally, showcasing it to impress the live audience staged in an intimate setting in the classroom. The course will be enjoyable, inspiring, practical and fulfilling for the students as they discover the joy and demands in a musical theatre performance.

EM 020 Technical Theatre

This course introduces students to what goes on behind the stage in theatre production and the magical team who brings all aspects of the production together seamlessly at backstage. The foundation training covers the basic areas of work in a professional theatre and technical aspects of the theatre such as Introduction to Technical Theatre, Fundamentals of Stage Management, Stage Lighting, Performance Sound and Costuming while understanding technical theatre as a career. A learning journey will be included as part of their knowledge gained about theatre set-up. Students will work on a scene and work towards staging it with the skills learnt. The course will be inspiring, practical and fulfilling for the students as they discover the power of every production role and its responsibilities.



EM 014 Professional Entertainer

Students will learn the secrets of being a successful party entertainer, from performing magic tricks to balloon sculpting. They will also learn to present the various means of livening up an occasion and then explore planning a show to suit different occasions such as parties, educational events or themed events. The highlight will be the opportunity for the students to perform to a community organisation at the end of the course.

EM 016 Music Producer

This is a complete training package which consists of songwriting, vocal techniques, producing original music accompaniment tracks and lastly, the recording of an original composition at a professional recording studio. Through the use of multimedia computer workstations, this course will train students to harness their creativity and learn how to create their own original dance/ techno loops based music accompaniment for the songs they have written. The students will be given the opportunity to complete their final project in a studio environment, after which, it will be mixed and mastered as a quality audio CD master.



EM 018 Drama Artiste

This course provides students with a platform to learn, develop, showcase and finally shine through their hidden acting talent and performing abilities in a showcase. Students will work with their fellow peers to develop skills in acting while understanding more about acting as a career. A learning journey will be included as part of their knowledge gained about theatre. The training includes voice/speech, acting, movement, improvisation, rehearsal through a series of theatre games and dramatic exercises leading to a performance for a live audience staged in an intimate setting in the classroom. As such, the course is practical, fun-filled, impactful and memorable for the students.



EM 021 Dance Choreographer (Jazz/ Hip Hop)

Love to watch dance performances and competitions on TV? Join us now to find out what it takes to be a Dance Choreographer. Mastereign Professionals' Dance Choreographer Module will break down all there is to know about choreographing dances for performance showcases, dance musicals and competitions. Every event will have its requirements and approaches to choreographing a great show. Choose from Jazz to Hip Hop Dance genres, building it as a Dance Choreographer.

Professionals



EM 022 Wedding Planner

This introductory course exposes students to the world of a professional wedding planner. Students will be involved in the whole planning process of understanding clients' needs and requirement, conceptualisation, choice of venues and putting the whole event together to create a long lasting memory. In this very dynamic course, students will go on field trips to popular wedding venues in Singapore, bridal boutiques, and even enjoy food tasting in a hotel. This allows students to fully appreciate the importance of every personnel committed to making a wedding event successful.



EM 024 Jewellery Design

The professional art of creating, crafting, fabricating, or rendering designs for jewellery, an ancient practice of the goldsmith or metalworker has evolved into a billion-dollar industry that falls under the category of what is commonly known as "functional art", or art that can be worn or used. Students will investigate the process of conceptualizing, designing, rendering and finally fabricating their designs. The finished product will be presented and donated to a charitable cause.



EM 026 Automotive Mechanic

With the rapid advancement in technology, the mechanic's job has evolved from being purely mechanical to include electronic technology. Because vehicles today possess complex computer and electronic systems, mechanics need to have a broader base of knowledge than in the past. In this workshop, students will explore the technical aspects of preparing a vehicle for motorsports competition.



EM 028 Beautician/Spa Tech

This course will equip students with the various techniques used for cosmetic treatments such as eye treatment, facial therapy and facial massage. Students will learn cosmetic techniques like make-up, eyebrow trimming, and eyelash perming and the required skills to perform manicures and pedicures. They will also gain exposure of the work environment in a beauty salon.



EM 023 Food and Beverage Manager

Being one of the countries in Asia to be coined as a 'food paradise', Singapore has no lack of eateries and restaurants. The growing trend of dining out has also seen an increase in the F&B industry. In this course, students will learn the art of managing and running a restaurant. The course is very hands-on as it will be real time learning and exposure in a restaurant.



EM 025 Florist

Floristry is the term used to describe the professional flora trade. It encompasses flower care and handling, flora design, arranging, merchandising, display and delivery. Students will learn about the cultivation of flowers as well as their arrangement and the business of selling them. A florist should be able to select flowers and other flora supplies and materials that will look good together based on principles and elements of flora design or market demands, and would be desirable for any events and occasions according to customers' requirements and expectations.



EM 027 Interior Designer

This course provides a foundational introduction to interior designing that covers designing tools, drawing, rendering and modelling. It offers a unique opportunity to explore creative approaches in solving technicalities in interior design, trends and modelling, while maintaining a strong understanding of the necessary skills for design development.



EM 029 Tourism (EBS Module)

This course provides students with a practical foundation when they want to further their curriculum-based studies in the areas of travel and tourism. It is designed to establish an awareness of concepts and perspectives relevant to the understanding of travel and tourism industries and to give students a framework form which to analyse the various aspects of these industries. This course will thus help make their progress to higher studies easier.



EM 030 **Entrepreneurship, Service and Retail Sales**

This workshop will take the participants through the complete process of entrepreneurship; from business formation to business idea generation to ground survey to actual business launch. Actual venture grounds may be a canteen fair, end-of-term bazaar, meet-the-parents fair or any other suitable opportunities. Thereafter, the participants will engage in a venture review in retrospect of the entrepreneurial process and plan for the next venture.



EM 032 **Junior Chef**

Every good chef or restaurateur who devotes himself seriously to the art of cookery or fine cuisine knows the great importance of good quality and exquisite material of fine food. The knowledge about food products should not be just the chef's concern but it should be taken seriously by whoever is involved directly or indirectly in food production, purchase and preparation. In this course, students not only learn about the preparation of a good meal, but also the origin, procurement and presentation of the finished product. The masterly fusion of fruits and vegetables in the recipes also promotes healthy living.



EM 034 **Sports and Health & Wellness**

An introductory course into the Sports Health & Fitness industry, students will learn to manage exercise in health and fitness centre and sports facilities and will gain knowledge in human movements studies in the field of exercise physiology, biomechanical principles, exercise psychology as well as sports safety and emergency responses.



EM 031 **Hairstylist**

The objective of this course is to provide an introduction to the hairstyling industry. It also provides the basis skills in hairstyling, such as product knowledge, handling long and short hairstyles, colouring and dyeing and fashion sense. This course serves as an excellent stepping-stone for students who wish to pursue a career in this area.



EM 033 **Hospitality (EBS Module)**

The element of business skills module offers an opportunity for students to learn and practice concepts and skills in the Retail, Hospitality and Travel and Tourism industries. With the expectation of a surge in demand for skilled hospitality professionals in the services industries brought on by the Singapore Integrated Resorts, students will find the program invaluable. Armed with in-depth knowledge of the prevalent industrial practices and equipped with the skills, students will find themselves highly in demand and ready to take on careers in the Service Industries.



EM 035 **Adventure/Teambuilding Instructor**

As an introductory course into the adventure industry, students will learn to manage adventures related equipment, and at the same time gain relevant knowledge in areas such as teambuilding, creating rapport and leading an unfamiliar group. Students will also be taught the proper and correct response in the event of an emergency. Spanning areas such as trekking, amazing races, survivor-style camps, fun-filled water excursions and many others, this course will also set students on the path to becoming an outdoor specialist, with the ability to craft and run adventure camps of all kinds. Skills in leadership, teambuilding, discipline, self-motivation and other core life skills are prevalent throughout the course and will play a great role in allowing students to help others help themselves.



EM 036 Airline Services

The objective of this course is to provide an insight into what it is like to be a crew, be it cockpit, cabin, or ground services crew. It also provides a better understanding in airport facilities and services and in-flight procedures. It sheds light on the need for requirements for stringent measures adopted by airports and airline carriers.



EM 038 Image Consultant

The objective of this course is to provide an introduction into the image consulting industry. It also provides the basis skills in skincare, makeup, attitudes, etiquette, communication and dress sense. Students will develop an interest in the area of image consultancy after this course and will see this as an excellent stepping-stone to pursue a career in this area.



EM 040 Community Services Consultant *(NEW)*

This programme relates to work across the community sector but particularly in organisations involved in community care services in a range of aged care or disability services settings, such as residential facilities homes and community agencies.



EM 037 Fashion Designer

Students will be introduced to the various aspects and processes of the fashion industry, including design accessories drawing and fabrics. It offers a unique opportunity to explore creative approaches in solving technicalities in garment design and production while maintaining a strong understanding of the necessary skills for design development.



EM 039 Nursing *(NEW)*

Nursing is a career that is both fulfilling and rewarding. This service-oriented programme aims to equip students with knowledge and skills to make significant contributions to healthcare and professional nursing practice.



EM 041 Practitioner TCM *(NEW)*

With the development of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) over the past few decades and increasing interest in complementary medicine the world over; public interest in TCM has also risen. TCM has been considered as part of Chinese cultural heritage and tradition. The course will prepare students with the introductory clinical skills and attitudes required to deliver effective patient care within the healthcare sector, sound knowledge to compound extemporaneous preparations, practical dispensing skills and an understanding of healthcare systems. In addition, students will be exposed to various Chinese Martial Arts such as Qui Gong and Wing Chuan. Qi Gong (vital energy exercises) and Tui Na (therapeutic massage).

EM 042 Casino Supervisor *(NEW)*

Students will learn how casino games are conducted with a wide range of skills and calculation methods. Students will gain understanding of the principles behind methods used to conduct games by casinos such as security measures, procedures and work etiquette. Students will learn the preparations required to perform casino floor staff duties and understand the mechanics of gaming protection against theft and fraud.
